Safety and Security is our priority

Parents and visitors are asked to identify themselves at the office and pick up a visitor's or volunteer's badge that they are required to wear during their stay and return to us upon their departure. We would like to remind parents that they are <u>not</u> permitted to use the school parking lot before, during and after school hours.

Parents are reminded that they must **not** double park when dropping off or picking up their children. It is also prohibited to block our busses or to park inappropriately on Nantel street near the bus zone.
