End of Cycle Exams:

It is important to note that the End of Cycle exams for students in Grades 4 and 6 take place throughout the months of **April, May, and June**. If your child is absent during one of these evaluations, it will be impossible to make up (without valid medical documentation) and they will receive a mark of ZERO. Moreover, since each exam takes place over the course of a few days, missing a day during this period will have a significant impact on their final result. In Cycle 3, Year 2 (Grade 6), these exams in English Language Arts, *Français Langue d'Enseignement*, and Mathematics are worth **20%** of the student's final mark.
